


Water Main Breaks per 100 Miles per Year



Estimated Useful Life and Breaks








Rising Construction Costs




Percent Increase Since 2000 of Midwest Construction Index and Midwest CPI



Consumption Decline




Average Monthly Residential Consumption (Gallons)
