Marcia Wiblin-Whited, Risk Management Specialist, Risk Management, is designated as the Title VI Coordinator for the City of Fort Wayne.

The City of Fort Wayne ADA Grievance Procedure is adopted for addressing complaints alleging discrimination under Title VI in the provision of services, activities, programs or benefits by the City of Fort Wayne with complaints to be directed to the Title VI Coordinator.

For notice purposes, the City of Fort Wayne will post the contact information regarding the Title VI Coordinator and the City of Fort Wayne's Title VI Nondiscrimination Policy on its website and at such other locations as may be determined from time to time.

Title VI Assurances (With Appendix A, B, and C)

City of Fort Wayne Title VI Assurances

The City of Fort Wayne (hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient") HEREBY AGREES THAT as a condition to receiving any Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d-42 U.S.C. 2000d-4 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation-Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes - Implementation and Review Procedures (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) and other pertinent nondiscrimination authorities and directives, to the end that in accordance with the Act, Regulations, and other pertinent nondiscrimination authorities and directives, no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race color, or national origin, sex (23 USC 324), age (42 USC 6101), disability/handicap (29 USC 790) and low income (Executive Order 12898) be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the Recipient receives Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, including the Federal Highway Administration, and HEREBY GIVES ASSURANCE THAT it will promptly take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement. This assurance is required by Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, subsection 21.7(a)(1) and Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, section 200.9(a) (1) of the Regulations, copies of which are attached.

More specifically and without limiting the above general assurance, the Recipient hereby gives the following specific assurances with respect to its Federal Aid Highway Program.

- 1. That the Recipient agrees that each "program" and each "facility as defined in 49 CFR subsections 21.23(e) and (b) and 23 CFR 200.5(k) and (g) of the Regulations, will be (with regard to a "program") conducted, or will be (with regard to a "facility") operated in compliance with all requirements imposed by, or pursuant to, the Regulations.
- 2. That the Recipient shall insert the following notification in all solicitations for bids for work or material subject to the Regulations and made in connection with all Federal-Ald Highway Programs and, in adapted form in all proposals for negotiated agreements:

The recipient in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation and Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes, issued pursuant to such Acts, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contact entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identify, age, disability/handicap, religion and / or low income in consideration for an award.

- 3. That the Recipient shall insert the clauses of Appendix A of this assurance in every contract subject to the Acts and the Regulations.
- 4. That the Recipient shall insert the clauses of Appendix B of this assurance, 'as a covenant running with the land, in any deed from the United States effecting a transfer of real property, structures, or improvements thereon, or interest therein.
- 5. That where the Recipient receives Federal financial assistance to construct a facility, or part of a facility, the assurance shall extend to the entire facility and facilities operated in connection therewith.

- 6. That where the Recipient receives Federal financial assistance in the form, or for the acquisition of real properly or an interest in real property, the assurance shall extend to rights to space on, over or under such property.
- 7. That the Recipient shall include the appropriate clauses set forth in Appendix C of this assurance, as a covenant running with the land, in any future deeds, leases, permits, licenses, and similar agreements entered into by the Recipient with other parties: (a) for the subsequent transfer of real property acquired or improved under the Federal-Aid Highway Program; and (b) for the construction or use of or access to space on, over or under real property acquired, or improved under the Federal-Ald Highway Program.
- 8. That this assurance obligates the Recipient for the period during which Federal financial assistance is extended to the program, except where the Federal financial assistance is to provide, or is in the form of, personal property, or real property or interest therein or structures or improvements thereon, in which case the assurance obligates the Recipient or any transféree for the longer of the following periods: (a) the period during which the property is used for a purpose for which the Federal financial assistance is extended, or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits; or (b) the period during which the Recipient retains ownership or possession of the property.
- 9. The Recipient shall provide for such methods of administration for the program as are found by the Secretary of Transportation or the official to whom he delegates specific authority to give reasonable guarantee that it, other recipients, subgrantees, contractors, subcontractors, transferees, successors in interest, and other participants of Federal financial assistance under such program will comply with all requirements imposed or pursuant to the Act, the Regulations and this assurance.
- 10. The Recipient agrees that the United States has a right to seek judicial enforcement with regard to any matter arising under the Act, the Regulations, and this assurance.

During the performance of this contract, the contractor, for itself, its assignees, and successors in interest (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor"), agrees as follows:

1. Compliance with Regulations
The Contractor shall comply with the Regulations relative to nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the
U.S. Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as DOT), Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 21,
and the Federal Highway Administration (hereinafter 'FHWA'), Title 23, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200 as
they may be emended from time to time, (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations), which are herein incorporated

2. Nondiscrimination
The Contractor, with regard to the work performed by it during the contract, shall not discriminate on the grounds of religion, race, color, or national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age and disability/handleap and low income in the selection and retention of subcontractors, including procurement of materials and leases of equipment. The Contractor shall not participate either directly or indirectly in discrimination prohibited by 49 CFR, section 21.5 of the Regulations, including employment practices when the contract covers a program set forth in Appendix B of the Regulations.

3. Solicitations for Subcontracts, including Procurement of Materials and Equipment in all solicitations either by competitive bidding or negotiations made by the Contractor for work to be performed under a subcontract, including procurement of materials or leases of equipment, each potential subcontractor or supplier shall be notified by the Contractor of the Contractor's obligations under this contract and the Regulations relative to nondiscrimination on the ground of religion, race, color, or national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age and disability/handicap and low income.

4. Information and Reporto
The Contractor shall provide all information and reports required by the Regulations or directives issued pursuant thereto, and shall permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information, and its facilities as may be determined by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, the Indiana Department of Transportation, or the Federal Highway Administration to be pertinent to ascertain compliance with such Regulations, orders and Instructions. Where any information required of a contractor is in the exclusive possession of another who fails or refuses to furnish this information, the Contractor shall so certify to the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, the Indiana Department of Transportation, or the Federal Highway Administration as appropriate, and shall set forth what efforts it has made to obtain the information.

6. Sanctions for Noncompliance In the event of the Contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination provisions of the contract, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, with Indiana Department of Transportation and/or the Federal Highway Administration concurrence, shall impose such contract sanctions determined to be appropriate, including, but not limited to:

(a.) Withholding of payments to the contractor under the contract until the contractor compiles, and/or (b.) Cancellation, termination or suspension of the contract, in whole or in part.

6. Incorporation of Provisions:
The contractor shall include the provisions of paragraphs (1) through (6) in every subcontract, including procurements of materials and leases of equipment, unless exempt by the Regulations, or directives issued pursuant thereto.

The Contractor shall take such action with respect to any subcontractor or procurement as the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, Indiana Department of Transportation or the Federal Highway Administration may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for noncompliance. Provided, however, that in the event a Contractor becomes involved in, or is threatened with, liligation with a subcontractor or supplier as a result of such direction, the Contractor may request the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana to enter into such liligation to protect the interests of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana and, in addition, the Contractor may request the United States to enter into such liligation to protect the interests of the United States.

Appendix B

A. The following clauses shall be included in any and all deeds effecting or recording the transfer of real properly, structures or improvements thereon, or interest therein from the United States.

(GRANTING CLAUSE)

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department of Transportation, as authorized by law, and upon the condition that the City of Port Wayne, Indiana will accept Title to the lands and maintain the project constructed thereon, in accordance with Title 23, United States Code of Federal Regulations the Regulations for the Administration of Federal-Ald Transportation Program and the policies and procedures prescribed by INDOT or FHWA and, also in accordance with and in compliance with all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation and Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) pertaining to and effectuating the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252; 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4), does hereby remise, release, quitclaim and convey unto the City of Fort Wayne, Judiana all the right, Title and Interest of the Department of Transportation in and to said lands described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

(HABENDUM CLAUSE)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD sold lands and interests therein unto the City of Port Wayne, Indiana and its successors forever, subject, however, to the covenants, conditions, restrictions and reservations herein contained as follows, which will remain in effect for the period during which the real property or structures are used for a purpose for which Federal financial assistance is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits and shall be binding on the City of Port Wayne, Indiana, its successors, and assigns.

The City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, in consideration or the conveyence of said lands and interests in lands, does hereby covenant and agree as a covenant running with the land for itself, its successors and assigns, that (1) no person shall on the grounds of religion, race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, ago, and disability/handicap and low income he excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination with regard to any facility located wholly or in part on over or under such lands hereby conveyed [.][and)*(2) that the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana shall use the lands and interests in lands and interests in lands so conveyed; in compilance with all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation — Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes-Implementation and Review Procedures, and as end Regulations may be amended [.] and (3) that in the event of breach of any of the abovementioned nondiscrimination conditions, the Department shall have a right to re-enter said lands and facilities on said land, and the above described land and facilities shall thereon revert to and vest in and become the absolute property of the Department of Transportation and its assign as such interest existed prior to this instruction.*

The following clauses shall be included in all deeds, licenses, leases, permits, or similar instruments entered into by the City of Port Wayne, Indiana pursuant to the provisions of Assurance 7(a).

The (grantee, Ilcensee, Iossee, permitee, etc., as appropriate) for himself, his heirs, personal representatives, successors in interest, and assigns, as a part of the consideration hereof, does herby covenant and agree (in the case of deeds and leases add "as a covenant running with land") that in the event facilities are constructed, maintained, or otherwise operated on the said properly described in this (deed, Ilcense, lease, permit, etc.) for a purpose for which a Department of Transportation program or activity is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits, the (grantee, Ilcensee, lossee, permitee, etc.) shall maintain and operate such facilities and services in compliance with all other requirements imposed pursuant to "fille 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation — Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1984, Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes-implementation and Review Procedures, and as said Regulations may be amended.

That in the event of breach of any of the above nondiscrimination covenants, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana shall have the right to terminate the [license, lease, pennit, etc.] and to re-enter and repossess sold land and the facilities thereon, and hold the same as if said picenses, lease, permit, etc.] had never been made or issued.

[Include in deed.]*

That in the event of breach of any of the above nondiscrimination covenants, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana shall have the right to reenter said lands and facilities thereon, and the above described lands and facilities shall thereupon revert to and vest in and become the absolute property of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana and its assigns.

The following shall be included in all deeds, licenses, leases, permits, or similar agreements entered into by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana pursuant to the provisions of Assurance 7(b).

The (grantee, Ilcensee, lessee, permitee, etc., as appropriate) for himself, his personal representatives, successors in interest, and assigns, as a part of the consideration hereof, does hereby covenant and agree (in the case of deads, and leases add "as a covenant running with the land") that (1) no person on the ground of religion, race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identify, age, disability/handicap and low income shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or he otherwise subjected to discrimination in the use of said facilities, (2) that in the construction of any improvements on, over or under such land and the furnishing of services thereon, no person on the ground of religion, race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability/handicap and low income shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination, (3) that the (grantee, licensee, lessee, permitee, etc.) shall use the premises in compliance with all other requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation — Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1984, Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations may be amended.

City of Fort Wayne, Indiana Title VI Notice to the Public

The City of Fort Wayne, Indiana hereby gives public notice that it is the City's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and the related statues and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, low income status or limited English proficiency be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any Federal Aid Highway program or other activity for which the City Of Fort Wayne, Indiana receives federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana. Any such complaint must be filed with the City within sixty (60) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. All items in bold must be completed for your complaint to be investigated. Failure to provide complete information may impair the investigation of your complaint.

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended and its related statutes and regulations (Title VI) prohibit discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, disability, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, low income, or limited English proficiency (LEP) in connection with programs or activities receiving federal financial assistance from the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration. These prohibitions extend to The City of Fort Wayne, Indiana as a direct recipient of federal financial assistance and to its sub-recipients, consultants, and contractors, whether federally funded or not.





Limited English Speaking Households (5 years and over)




# EXHIBIT #12: 2022 American Community Survey Map: Fort Wayne Minority Population
